

DNA Career Mobility Scholarship Criteria and Application Information

Purpose: To fund the continuing nursing education of a Dermatology Nurses Association (DNA) member that will enhance his/her ability to contribute to the dermatologic community.

Criteria: The candidate must:

1. Be a current DNA member for a minimum of 2 consecutive and complete years of membership.
2. Be employed in the specialty of dermatology for minimum of 2 years.
3. Be pursuing a degree in nursing.
4. Be accepted as a student in a certified nursing or advanced practice nursing program.
5. Must write an article for Focus within one year of winning award.

Submission: The candidate shall submit a completed Career Mobility Scholarship application consisting of 7 questions and 3 essay questions. The candidate must also submit proof of enrollment in a certified school of nursing or advanced practice nursing program.

Prior to receiving the scholarship grant, the award winner is required to submit a current receipt from his/her educational institution registrar's office. The receipt must reflect that award winner is enrolled at the time the scholarship grant is received.

Applications must be postmarked on or before October 1

Decisions of scholarship recipients are determined by blind review of all applications by the Awards/Scholarship committee.

One scholarship will be awarded annually. The recipient will be awarded a \$1000 educational scholarship to assist in the pursuit of a nursing degree.
